
Wintershall Travelling Crib 2025 Pupil and Teacher Voice

Accompanying Adult: We walked away from the event and said, 'that was amazing!' As a parent, I found it really calm and reflective and loved being outside in beautiful surroundings.




Year 6 Class teacher: The wonder of this event for our older students was amazing to see. Children thought they knew the story, but at every character, they learnt something new.
